General

PAWARA offers the jumble trail as a convenient and enjoyable way for sellers to offer items they no longer need for reuse and for buyers to pick up bargains.

We have put together a few points to help the event go smoothly.

Sellers

Anyone wishing to participate can simply put items they wish to sell (or give away) in their front garden or driveway for others to browse.

Pavements and other shared spaces, such as shared driveways, must be kept clear.

You are responsible for the sale of your goods. What you charge is up to you.

To keep everyone safe we ask that none of the following goods are offered or sold during the event:

Alcohol, tobacco or vape products, drugs of any kind, knives or weapons of any kind.

We will compile and publish a list of properties participating.

It would be useful to have a brief summary of the type of items you are offering, but that is not essential.

If you put balloons or a “Jumble Trail” sign outside your property on the day it will help buyers to find you.

Buyers

Please park with consideration for neighbours and other road users and avoid blocking driveways and parking on pavements.

Any agreement to purchase goods is made between the buyer and the seller.

We recommend you check the condition of goods and they are as described before buying.

PAWARA takes no responsibility for goods offered or sold and will not intervene in any disputes.

Please take cash with you. Be wary of anyone who asks to take payment by card.

Bring some bags. Don't miss out on bargains because you have nothing to carry them in.
